All students should have:

- #2 pencils
- blue or black ink pens
- Pencil case

6th & 7th grader students will have school-provided Chromebooks. 8th grade students have a “Bring Your Own Device” policy for student laptop computers (iPads will not be powerful enough). Students should familiarize themselves with the use of their device before the start of school and bring it with them on the first day.

Specific to 6th Grade Humanities:

- A supply of colorful pens or fine-point markers to be used for journaling
- Composition Notebook for journaling
- Post It Tabs
- At least 3 glue sticks
- Headphones or earbuds

Specific to Grades 7 & 8 History:

- 1.5”- 2” binder
- Dividers for the binder (Minimum of 8 dividers)
- Post It Tabs

Specific to Math:

- Graph paper (7th and 8th grade math only)
- A scientific calculator (both graphing or non-graphing are OK)
- 1.5”- 2” binder
- Loose leaf paper

Specific to Grades 7 & 8 English:

- 1” Binder
- 5 dividers for the binder
- Highlighters

Specific to World Language:

- 6, 7, 8 - Mandarin
 - **NO BINDER REQUIRED - Students are welcome to use one if they like.**
 - **NO LOOSE LEAF PAPER! :)**
 - **Notebook** for Vocabulary and Notes
 - I personally like smaller notebooks for this type of note taking. Perhaps something like [this](#). That said, any notebook will work.
 - **Two Pocket Folder** - One side for work in progress, the other side for completed work. This is absolutely necessary. I recommend something made of plastic, as folders are subject to substantial wear and tear.
- Spanish
 - 1" binder
 - Composition notebook

Specific to Science:

- 1.5" Binder
- 4 dividers
- Loose leaf paper
- 3 X 5 note cards

Suggested materials for staying organized:

- Post-its for marking important passages in textbooks
- 3 x 5 note cards for flash cards
- Student Planner
