Thank you for your interest in Vail Mountain School and the Taft Conlin Scholarship. VMS is an academically challenging K-12, independent school that prepares students both in and out of the classroom. 100% of VMS graduates are accepted to four year colleges or universities.

The scholarship honors Taft Conlin, a member of the VMS community who died in 2012. This scholarship is intended to keep his legacy alive by offering opportunities for deserving, high achieving students, with a commitment to their community, to attend Vail Mountain School. This distinguished, merit-based award provides full tuition until graduation and is open to students entering grade 9 in the Fall of 2023.

Students wishing to be considered for the Taft Conlin Scholarship must submit the following items:

- Completed application for the Scholarship (attached), due January 15, 2023
- Parent recommendations
- Teacher recommendations
- Principal recommendation
- Most recent report card or progress report
- Current school records (including standardized test scores and previous 3 years' grades)
- Students are asked to complete a visit day and interview with the Director of Upper School. (contact the admission office to schedule) prior to January 15th
- Complete the online financial assistance application.
